## BIOGRAPHY

In this role, she investigated and prosecuted licensure complaints against various health care practitioners, including doctors, nurses, pharmacists, dentists, veterinarians, and health facility administrators.

Erika also worked as Staff Attorney at the Indiana State Department of Health, where her practice focused on administrative litigation and regulatory enforcement involving home health care agencies, health care facilities, and environmental matters.

Erika received her law degree from Indiana University Robert H. McKinney School of Law with a certificate in Health Law. As a law student, she gained valuable experience working as a judicial extern to Magistrate Judge Mark Dinsmore of the Southern District Court of Indiana. Additionally, Erika served as Senior Legislative Assistant and Intern Director for the Indiana House of Representatives and as Deputy Legislative Director for the Indiana Family and Social Services Administration.

Erika graduated from Indiana University Bloomington with a Bachelor of Arts, where she was a Cox Scholar and a Director of

the Indiana University Memorial Union Board. Erika is active in the Indianapolis community, serving in executive leadership roles with the Junior League of Indianapolis and the Indianapolis Bar Association's Women in the Law Division.
